

MemCo workshop "Memristors for Computing" on 11/19-21/2012

The MemCo workshop "Memristors for Computing" will be held on the 19-21 November 2012 at the Villa Clythia, Fréjus, France. It aims to bring together different communities interested in memristor devices and their applications, from condensed matter to hardware implementation. The **deadline to register and submit an abstract is July 31st, 2012**

At the MemCo workshop, memristor is taken in the broadest sense, ranging from binary to multi-state memories, to be used for logic, reconfigurable or neuromorphic architectures. The conference is co-organized by the "Unité Mixte de Physique CNRS/Thales" Palaiseau, "IEF" Orsay, "CEA-LIST" Saclay and "IMS" Bordeaux.

The workshop will consist of invited talks and poster sessions. Meals and accommodation are free of charge. The number of participants is limited to 100.
